Cucalorus Connect Categories

Keynote Speaker: Provides new, valuable content in the form of a speech, presentation, or fireside chat during an all-conference session in our largest venue. All-conference sessions generally run 90 minutes but keynote speeches vary from 20-45 minutes.

Breakout Session: Panel discussion or workshop, which provides an activity that teaches a skill or offers a chance to experiment with new concepts. Breakout sessions generally run 60 minutes in rooms with 30-70 people.

Rocket Pitch: Offers start-ups a chance to earn initial funding to launch new ideas into the marketplace, through a 2-5 minutes presentation.

10x10 Challenge: Pairs ten filmmakers with ten entrepreneurs and challenges each team to make a video together during the week of the Cucalorus Festival. Final videos are screened for audiences on Sunday, November 11. Businesses must be 3 years or younger to apply. We accept filmmakers at all levels of experience.

Branded Video Showcase: Original, creative content from successful brands. Submit through the Cucalorus Film Entry Form.

Examples: commercials, product demos, films funded by corporations, etc.

Virtual Reality: We accept completed films or other VR experiences, as well as demos for new gear, headsets, and games. Please indicate if you can provide your own equipment. Submit through the Cucalorus Film Entry Form.
